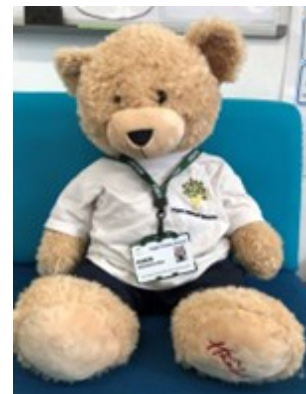

An Update on Safety Measures Around the School

Thank you to all our parents who completed the survey and shared your views on security around our school premises. Here is a summary of updates:



- Robust evacuation and lockdown procedures, and drills have been practised by all staff and children.
- CCTV cameras have been installed all around the school building for improved vigilance
- The School Office doors can only be opened by the Office Team.
- More lighting has been put in our Key Stage 2 playground area
- Harrow Met Officers patrol the school boundary weekly and speak with the local community residents and parents to ensure safety
- Parent volunteers (in hi-vis vests) monitor outside the school gates during drop off and collection times.

During the summer term, the school will endeavour to have additional fencing and meshing outside the Key Stage 2 and EYFS gates, as well as gates outside the Office doors.
