How to separate my recycling



Sark is introducing weekly kerbside collections of blue and clear bag recycling from 1st January 2022. Having successfully run in Guernsey for a number of years Sark residents now have an opportunity to recycle plastic, tins, and cartons, paper and cardboard every week.

Both a blue and clear bag will be collected along with your black bag rubbish on your normal collection. See overleaf for how to separate your blue and clear bag waste.

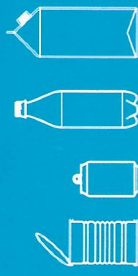

What goes in my blue bag

PLASTIC, TINS AND CARTONS:

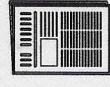
- Plastic bottles, pots and trays
- Plastic and metal bottle tops
- Tins and cans
- Aerosols (empty)
- Aluminium foil (clean)
- Juice and food cartons
- Milk cartons

NO THANKS!

- Carrier bags, bread bags and cling film
- 'Peel off' plastic lids
- Polythene and bubble wrap
- Plastic toys
- Crisp packets and pet food pouches
- Polystyrene packaging
- Black plastic

Rinse and clean

Please clean or at least rinse any items before placing in your blue bag. The cleaner the recycling the easier it is to recycle.



What goes in my clear bag

PAPER AND CARDBOARD:

- Cardboard and thin card
- Paper, envelopes and junk mail
- Newspapers and magazines
- Shredded paper

NO THANKS!

- Milk cartons
- Juice and food cartons
- Tissues and paper towels



For all other waste e.g. food, glass and non recyclables please dispose as you normally would until further notice.
