

## AMHR and ASPC Show Bill

- This show is approved and sanctioned by the American Shetland Pony Club and the American Miniature Horse Registry, Morton, Ill. All horses entered must be registered by AMHR/ASPC/ASPR to show.
- Show management and/or show Steward reserve the right to settle
  and determine all questions, differences and disputes arising out of or
  connected with an incident to the show within the boundaries of
  AMHR/ASPC/ASPR's current rules.
- All horses entered must have health papers signed by a certified vet within 30 days of show date, listing the above-mentioned show.
   Coggins required for out-of-state horses.
- Measuring Friday at 4:00 pm and Saturday & Sunday mornings at 7:30am.
- Gelding status must be noted on horse registration papers to show.
- Stalls available from noon Friday July 7 and must be vacated by 10:00 pm on Sunday. Stalls are \$75.00 for the weekend. Shavings are \$9 per bag and will need to be purchased with entries. 2 bags required per stall. NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED. All horses must be stalled, limit of two horses per stall. NO JUMP OUTS. No nails/staples can be used on the stalls. TACK STALLS MAYBE LIMITED TO ONE PER GROUP.
- Single Classes are \$30 (including Liberty). Unlimited classes are \$85
  with an additional fee of \$10 for Liberty class if part of unlimited fee.
  Office fee is \$10 per back number. Entry fees are not refundable
  without a veterinary certificate. Office fee is non-refundable.
- All dogs must be always on a leash.
- NO SMOKING allowed within the confines of the barns at facility.
- Parking: After unloading vehicles and trailers, they must be parked in the designated area. No parking near fire exits, or main drive.
- RV/Camping: Parking for RV/Campers available for \$30 per night with hookups for water/electricity/waste removal. Please note on your entry form how many spaces are needed.
- NO PAINTING OF HOOFS ON CEMENT. You must use something under horse's feet so as not to leave hoof black on the floor.
- Awards: Ribbons 1st 6th place; ribbons for Champion/Reserve Champion.

- The Ellsworth Equestrian Center is located on Hwy 65 just south of lowa Falls at 709 Ellsworth Avenue. It is the larger of the two buildings.
- Many restaurant and grocery options within driving of the facility. There

- All Add & Scratches MUST be made at least 2 divisions prior and must have an Add & Scratch slip made out for the show management.
- All Tack Changes/Hold must be made to the gate person at least two classes ahead.
- The two-minute gate call will be enforced. Class announcements to the barns are a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for classes and to know what classes they are in.
- Announcements of actual times will be made at the show for lunch breaks etc..
- Show Farrier is Lauren Faas, and John Hallberg is on call for vet services. Contact details posted at show.
- Your support helps keep our show going! Please consider sponsoring a class. Class sponsorships are \$25.00 per class.
- Show entry payments are accepted through: PayPal, Venmo, Credit
  Card, cash, or check. Convenience fee will apply for all non-check or
  cash payments. Contact the show manager for ways of payment.
- Entries must be postmarked by Friday, June 20, 2024.
- At check in: Entries must have a copy of papers with them, a current measurement card within the last 60 days or a permanent card, and a copy of current Youth and Amateur cards.
