The **Timberlane Community Music Association (TCMA)**, launched in 2019, has enjoyed success through the last years. The band persevered through the challenges in 2020 and 2021 and came back in 2022 with a pops-inspired Variety Show showcasing talented musicians and singers from the TCMA family.

What began as a very small group of concert band musicians and music supporters in 1999 developed into the Timberlane Community Band. In the mid 2000s, the Timberlane Jazz Band was created and this group has grown in talent under the guidance of Nick Mainella and now John Mainella.

Both of our bands have performed regularly in their Summer Concert Series, as well as at the Timberlane Performing Arts Center (PAC) under the guidance of Tony DiBartolomeo, Gil Lapointe and John Mainella in Atkinson, Plaistow and Hampstead.

We enjoy and look forward to continuing our support in the Timberlane school district and the surrounding communities by bringing live music back into the forefront of everyday life.

TCMA Mission Statement

The Timberlane Community Music Association (TCMA)
TCMA's mission is deeply rooted in the concept of
"community" and in encouraging involvement in music
for the people at all stages of life. TCMA's mission is
to be a leader in performance and music education,
while reaffirming the heritage of bands in America.
This Mission incorporates five objectives:

- To make a substantial contribution to musical life locally.
- To give our audiences memorable performance experiences with the highest quality wind music in a wide range of musical styles.
- To foster and promote wind music through concerts, live streaming, and recordings.
- To assist in the music education of young people the future generation of adult musicians – through the presentation of concerts, special membership invitations, and scholarships.
- To provide our members with an opportunity for musical expression, growth, and fellowship.

TCMA Education Outreach

TCMA has awarded scholarships to high school seniors in the Timberlane Regional School District (TRSD) who are heading off to college to study music. TCMA also subsidizes the private lesson program of the TRSD where students are invited to play with the band and are given financial aid toward their private lessons. This commensurates with the level of commitment demonstrated to the community band. TRSD students who are members of the local Tri-M chapter are also invited to play with the TCMA Community Band to fulfill their community service requirements.

A new initiative (2023) to help facilitate the study of uncommon instruments (Oboe, Bassoon, French Horn, and other instruments) that require extra study or expense, is being funded by TCMA. We cover half the cost of 10 private lessons (\$150 toward the \$300 for a block of 10 private lessons). This award is offered to Timberlane Middle and High School students, chosen by the Timberlane High School Music Department, to get started on a second instrument and expand the capabilities of the school ensembles to play a wider range of music.



What do we do with our proceeds?



Since the inception of the Timberlane Community Band in late 1999, then becoming the Timberlane Community Music Association (TCMA) in Fall of 2019, the organization has proudly donated several specialty Instruments including a Bass Saxophone and Bass Flute to the Timberlane Music Department. The TCMA also donated a PA system for the Performing Arts Center (PAC). Other donations are Row "K" auditorium seats for the Performing Arts Center, a sheet music storage cabinet, as well as partnering in the construction of the Amphitheater at the Kimball Library in Atkinson. In addition, past scholarships have been awarded to Timberlane District Seniors who are furthering their musical education.
