St. Andrew's, Roker, commonly known as the Arts and Crafts Cathedral of the North East, was built in 1906 - 1907. Designed by Edward S. Prior, a doyen of the Arts and Crafts movement, its rugged grandeur, so fitting for its coastal location, reveals an interior marked by the beauty of craftsmanship, design and decoration, with work by Burne-Jones, William Morris, Edward Gimson, Randall Wells, Eric & Macdonald Gill and H. A. Payne

After year-long Centenary celebrations which included exhibitions, concerts and workshops in the visual and performing arts, Friends of St. Andrew's has been formed.
