DORMANT

- Winter

### **Dormant Oil**

Apply: December / January or  
Up to Just Before Buds Swell.



Kills Overwintering Insects.

\*\* Mix 6 Tbs. / #1 Gal. of Water

\*\* Always Follow Label Directions

### **Copper Soap – PEACHES ONLY**

*Apply During the Dormant Season*  
Apply Late Fall to  
Before Bud Break



To Prevent Peach Leaf Curl  
.5 – 2.0 Ounces /  
#1 Gal. Water

\*\* Always Follow Label Directions

### **Fire Blight Spray PEARS ONLY**

(Fruiting & Ornamental)

#### **Apply 2 Times**

- #1) As the Trees Come Into Bloom
- #2) Again in Full Flower



### **To Prevent Fire Blight**

Do Not Use Insecticides during  
Blooming Period - As the Products  
may be highly toxic to Bees.  
(Which Pollinate your Fruit Trees)

- 2 Tbs. / #1 Gal. Water

\*\* Always Follow Label Directions
