Only one Scotch Doubles tournament but it is unlimited number of players, only 1 Advanced on a team and single elimination.

Reminder from last year - Late fees are in effect and they will be enforced.
TEAM DIVISIONS have been changed. Only 1 Men's and 1 Women's division which are handicapped draws using the MPA format (commonly known as John Stich format).
