

## Champion Drive Exhibitor Application


The 2023 Austin County Fair is fast approaching. The 96<sup>th</sup> annual fair will begin with the Champion Drive on Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup> with all other fair events following through Sunday, October 15<sup>th</sup>. This will be the sixth year for the Champion Drive at the Austin County Fair and we are excitedly planning and preparing for the Champion Drive. This event will pair special needs students from our county with a "buddy" exhibitor and they will show at the Champion Drive Livestock Show on Friday, October 6, 2023.

The purpose of the Champion Drive is to provide special needs youth in Austin County the opportunity to participate first-hand, in a livestock show experience. The Champion Drive is for special needs youth that are not currently raising a project for the Austin County Fair. Special needs exhibitors will participate in a traditional multi-species show. Species that we could use are pigs, bucket calves, rabbits, goats, lambs, chickens and turkeys and will be matched based on the physical and emotional needs of exhibitor participating in the event. Each exhibitor will be assigned a "buddy." Buddies are 4-H and FFA members that will assist exhibitors with exhibition of the livestock projects. Each exhibitor in the show will receive awards, an exhibitor shirt, photo with their buddy and a catered lunch for all exhibitors, parents, buddies, teachers and sponsors. We are so excited to share the livestock showing experience with students that may have never ever thought that they could participate. We are even more excited to offer the opportunity to provide scholarship opportunities for exhibitors that might qualify.
