#### Applications due to the Fair office by 5:00 p.m. on the March 25, 2024

- 1. Evaluation of scholarship applications and the subsequent ranking of applicants shall be the sole responsibility of a designated committee, independent of the Austin County Fair. The president of the Austin County Fair, or his appropriate designee, must approve the selections submitted by the committee. Committee members involved in the selection process are not to be considered agents of the Austin County Fair. It is their independent responsibility to rank applicants who qualify according to the policies specified herein. Such policies and those who qualify as complying with such policies shall be determined solely by the Austin County Fair.
- 2. Eligible applicants must be graduating high school seniors in Austin County. A current official high school transcript is required. The official transcript MUST show the students GPA and the class ranking along with the number of students in the class. The current official transcript must be in a SEALED ENVELOPE (envelope must have been sealed by the school).
- 3. Applicant must be an active member and in good standing of Texas F.F.A., 4-H or F.C.C.L.A. To qualify, the applicant MUST have participated in the Austin County Fair a minimum of 2 years. (Example: Goats 2019-2021 or FCCLA 2019-2021). Working in the FFA/4-H coke stand or any other volunteer work does not qualify the applicant to receive a scholarship.
- 4. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled as full-time students and maintain a minimum course load of 12 semester hours (fall or spring semester) at an approved and accredited college, university or trade school and must maintain a minimum grade point average/ratio each semester of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent. Failure to complete 12 semester hours per regular semester may be grounds for termination.
- 5. Scholarship payments are sent directly to the college/trade school/university once the Fair office has received: (1) a copy of the schedule for the semester the scholarship amount is paying toward; (2) a copy of transcript reflecting all courses undertaken & must reflect rule #4 above; (3) an invoice with an open balance the scholarship amount will pay toward. The office must receive all of this information 10 days or more prior to the due date for processing.
- 6. Scholarship recipients must notify the Austin County Fair Association immediately upon deciding which college, university or accredited trade school they will attend, or changes in school, major, address and other pertinent information needed to keep the student's file up-to-date. - 7. Scholarship recipients must submit a copy of their grade report to the Austin County Fair Association no later than six weeks after the conclusion of their first college semester.
- 8. Failure to enroll in the selected college, university or accredited trade school for a fall or spring semester will be considered grounds for termination. Inactive status (staying out of school for a designated time) may be requested by the recipient. In such cases, the Austin County Fair Association Scholarship Committee will handle the matter on an individual basis and subsequently will approve or disapprove the request based on the unique circumstances involved.
- 9. Failure to comply or conform to the policies stated herein will be considered grounds for termination. Scholarship funds accepted by the recipient while in violation of stated policy must be repaid in full immediately upon receiving notification. Hardship cases, which result in a deviation from stated policy, will be considered and dealt with on an individual basis.
- 10. This application along with a school cap & gown photograph, 1 page essay answer essay prompt on Page 2 of the application, current official High School Transcript (in a sealed envelope) and the check list of scholarships must be turned into the Austin County Fair Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the March 25, 2024. All correspondence and information required must be presented to the Fair Office in a SEALED 9" x 12" ENVELOPE. On the outside of the sealed 9" x 12" envelope, please put the student's name, school and the scholarships for which they are applying.
