VILLAGE EAST RULES AND REQUIREMENTS for POOL, ACTIVITY COURTS, BOAT RAMP AND DOCKS

Use of Village East Property Owners Association (VEPOA) facilities is restricted to members, their family and guests. Members or their family must be present when their guests are using the facilities.

Village East homeowners extending their privileges to renters must be registered with the VEPOA Vice President.

Membership cards are required to use **ALL** Village East facilities.

Members are directly and completely responsible for the actions of their children, guests and renters while they are on the premises.

Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.

No alcoholic beverages, glass containers, loud music, or boisterous conduct is allowed at any of the facilities.

All VEPOA facilities are self-maintained. Take pride, clean up after yourself and take any refuse with you when leaving the area.

Village East Property Owners Association will not be responsible for any accidents, injuries, or loss of personal property.

All rules and requirements are posted at each individual facility and on the VEPOA website (*villageeast.org*).

By using these facilities, you have read and agreed to all the rules and requirements as specified on the following pages for the pool, activity courts, and boat launch & docks.

Member privileges may be suspended for violation of any rules.

POOL RULES

All members using the pool must sign in on the clipboard in the clubhouse.

Membership Card is required for entry into the pool area.

Members are directly and completely responsible for actions of their children, guests, and renters.

Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.

No alcoholic beverages, glass containers, animals, loud or boisterous conduct is allowed. No smoking in the pool area.

Hard objects such as footballs and frisbees are not allowed to be thrown in the pool area. Large rafts and floats that are more appropriate for the lake are not permitted in the pool.

The condition of our pool is an individual responsibility. Do not abuse the equipment. Clean your area, put back any equipment, and close the umbrellas when you leave.

Swimming is at your own risk. No lifeguard service is provided. All persons use the pool and clubhouse at their own risk.

Parking is allowed in the lot above the pool. Parking is limited, be considerate and careful. Parking is not permitted on Indian Ridge Drive.

Village East Property Owners Association will not be responsible for any accidents, injuries or loss of personal property.

Member privileges may be suspended for violating any of these pool rules.

ACTIVITY COURTS

The activity courts – basketball; tennis; and pickleball - are for their intended use ONLY. No bicycles, skateboards or wheeled vehicles. NO pets allowed.

If there are people waiting to use a court, please limit your play to 30 minutes.

Put all refuse in the provided trash container and ensure the gate is closed when you depart.

BOAT RAMP & DOCKS

Use of the boat launch area is restricted to members of Village East, their renters, and guests; all of whom must be prepared to show membership cards to use the facilities.

Members sponsoring others (out-of-town guests, etc.) must be present during usage of the facility.

Members are fully responsible for their own actions and those of their children, renters, guests, and pets within the boat launch area.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages and playing of loud music are prohibited.

Swimming and fishing are permitted at one's own risk.

Picnicking is permitted from dawn to dusk.

The chain that blocks the boat ramp must be replaced and locked after each use.

Mooring of boats and personal watercraft is restricted to loading and launching only. Be considerate of others – limit to 30 minutes.

Overnight mooring of boats and personal watercraft is prohibited. Boats and personal watercraft left overnight will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

Vehicle and trailer parking are limited. Vehicles must be parked away from the boat ramp launch area so as not to block access for others to use.

Users should ensure they take any refuse with them when leaving the area.

STOP Aquatic Hitchhikers. Watercraft from other bodies of water MUST be cleaned before entering the lake.

Member privileges **may be suspended** for violating any of these boat ramp and dock rules.
