It is March.

We plan to attend the regional meet in Breckenridge, Colorado this summer so the recent temperate weather had me out in my unheated garage performing maintenance. I was replacing tires. I've never done that before. Not fun.

Thanks to some collusion between Ford and Goodyear, there are 6 tires. Two spares? Really? In the engineering world, this is called redundancy. Maybe I've been lucky. Maybe the roads are much better than they were in 1931 but I've never even had a flat. And thank goodness for that because any time there is a need to use one, these side-mounted spares must be fully deflated so that they can be wrenched free of the fenders where they reside. 


