The Joyous Noise recipient for the month of November totaled \$118.51 and was designated to Operation Christmas Child. Operation Christmas Child is a ministry project run by Samaritan's Purse. Since 1993, God has used Samaritan's Purse to deliver over 200 million Operation Christmas Child shoebox gifts to children in need and disciple 50 million of these boys and girls.

The Joyous Noise recipient for the month of December totaled \$265.85 and was designated for PA Wounded Warrior. Pennsylvania Wounded Warriors, Inc. was founded on one major goal - to help over 1200 veterans and families each year with over \$1,500,000 in assistance. They provide emergency financial assistance to veterans to help pay for housing, utilities, transportation, medical and other expenses. They pay directly to landlords, vendors and creditors. Pennsylvania's veterans have served their nation in every conflict. Many of these men and women are recovering physically, mentally or emotionally at a military hospital, Veteran's Administration medical facility or with their families at home – and are in need of financial support. Through generous donations, they are able to assist our Pennsylvania veterans.






