






Realm Church Directory



PRAYER GUIDE

- **Sunday, May 19th:** Pentecost Sunday: Almighty God, on this day we remember how You poured out the marvelous gift of Your Holy Spirit upon Your faithful disciples. In the same way, pour out Your Spirit upon us that we too may once again be filled anew with the full measure of the love, holiness, and power of God, that we may serve You in joyful obedience all our days. Amen.
- **Monday, May 20th:** Prayerfully read or listen to Acts 2:1-13. Consider the number of times the word "all" is used as well as the number of times the word "each" (or "his own") is used. It might help to use a couple of different translations. What is important about the fact that BOTH "all" is used as well as "each"?
- **Tuesday, May 21st:** Prayerfully read or listen to Acts 2:1-13, specifically v. 4. See also Ephesians 3:16-19. What do you sense it means to be "filled" with the Holy Spirit, especially in light of the Ephesians passage? Do you know this "filling?" What is the evidence in your life? If not, or if you want more, ask the Lord; He is not stingy!
- **Wednesday, May 22nd:** FASTING DAY! Each Wednesday, we practice the spiritual discipline of Fasting. If you have not fasted before, or you have lapsed and want to try again, today and this week is a good time to try! Start small; one kind of food or one meal, or perhaps a type of social media for the day. Most importantly, PRAY PRAY!! Ask the Lord for His help and direction, and keep seeking the Lord throughout the day!
- **Thursday, May 23rd:** Prayerfully read or listen to Acts 2:1-13, with Matthew 5:48 with Lev. 19:2. Apart from the infilling of the Holy Spirit, can we obey either Christ's command in Matthew, or the command set out in Leviticus? See Romans 8:1-11. What does the indwelling Spirit give us that we cannot accomplish without Him?
- **Friday, May 24th:** Prayerfully read or listen slowly to Romans 8:1-11. Soak in the truth of your freedom in Christ through the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit! If you have not received the Holy Spirit, take time today and ask the Lord to give you this wonderful gift of His indwelling Presence. If you want a fresh, new anointing, ask Him! He is your loving Father and gives good gifts to His children!
- **Saturday, May 25th:** Take time to look over all the passages of Scripture we have studied and prayed over this week, as well as the things you have learned. Be still, and listen to what the Lord would tell you, personally, today.
