Ephesians 3:20-21

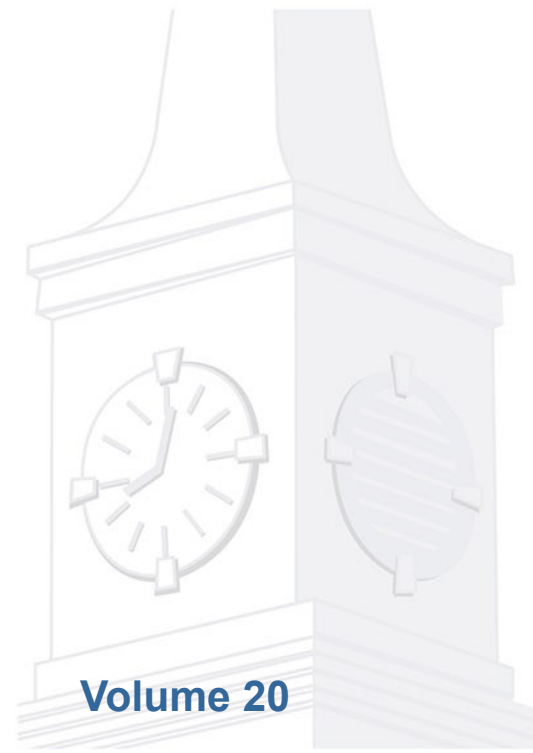
The first century church was challenged in its mission for Christ to convince the world that the resurrection and ascension of Christ seated at the right-hand of God did happen, as God had planned. The church moved by faith to proclaim the gospel. The "good news" was in fact, that Jesus gave His life and rose from the dead to testify of God's plan to redeem mankind, in a body of believers called the church.

The church is called to share the glory of Christ through the resurrection. Faith in Christ as the resurrected Lord and Savior is the foundation of new life in the church (Acts 2:36-40). Those who believe in Him are saved by Him. Being saved by Him, the church bears wit-

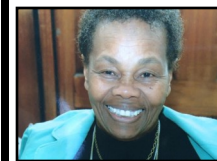
