## Questions to ask when shopping for Driver Education

By law EVERY driver education student is required to complete the following:
$>30$ hours of classroom instruction DWI components are covered in these classes
$>7$ HOURS BEHIND THE WHEEL TRAINING. The student must be driving for the FULL HOUR BEHIND THE WHEEL, being a passenger in the back seat does not fulfill these requirements.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. What is the cost of the class $\qquad$ does it include the NM required 7 hours of Behind the Wheel Drive Time $\qquad$ Written Exam $\qquad$ \& Road Test___or will I have to pay extra for those?
2. Will my child get private one-on-one driving lessons? $\qquad$
3. If not, will my child be required to sit in the back seat of a car with an amateur driver at the wheel? $\qquad$
4. If so there will be more than one student in the car, and does my child have to go out for 14 hours of driving? $\qquad$
(There are NO short-cuts each student must complete 7 full hours behind the wheel so if there is another passenger they will only get credit for 30 minutes or have to be in the car for 2 full hours)
5. How does my child sign-up for drive times? $\qquad$
6. How many available drive times do you offer per month? $\qquad$
7. What is your average class size? $\qquad$
