Section 1. Title

This Local Law shall be referred to as the Local Law imposing a moratorium on commercial energy development in the Town of Warren.

Section 2. Purpose and Intent

Pursuant to the statutory powers vested in the Town of Warren to regulate and control land use and promote the health, safety and welfare of its residents, the Town Board of the Town of Warren declares a twelve (12) month moratorium on the commercial energy development within the Town to allow the Town Board and the Planning Board to find more information and facts related to these developments within the Town.

The Town Board desires to effectuate its Comprehensive Plan and address, in a careful manner, the undertaking, establishment, siting, placement, construction, enlargement and erection of commercial energy development projects on a comprehensive Town-wide basis and to adopt new land use regulations to specifically regulate the same.

The Town Board finds that if commercial energy development in the Town proceeds under the current local laws it will lessen the ability of the Town to plan for its orderly development and protect the public health, safety and general welfare of the Town's citizens. Thus, the Town Board further finds and determines that it needs a period of time covered by the moratorium imposed herein in order to carefully adopt regulations for commercial energy development, schedule and hold required public hearing(s), perform the appropriate environmental reviews, comply with applicable provisions of law, adopt the local law(s), and file the same with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

The Town Board finds that pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(30) the adoption of a moratorium on land development or construction is a Type II action under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") which has been determined not to have a significant impact on the environment or is otherwise precluded from environmental review under Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8 and is therefore not subject to review under 6 NYCRR Part 617 or Environmental Conservation Law Article 8.

Section 3. Authority

This moratorium is enacted by the Town Board pursuant to its authority to adopt local laws under Article IX of the New York State Constitution and Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10.

Section 4. Scope of Controls

The Town of Warren shall not grant any approvals that would have as the result of establishment, implementation, placement or construction of any alternative energy development within the Town of Warren.

For purposes of this local law, commercial energy development shall include solar generation facilities, wind generation facilities, and other large-scale generating facilities. This local law does not regulate or preclude issuance of permits for small-scale residential solar for residential use only.

Section 5. Hardship.

Should any owner of property affected by this Local Law suffer an unnecessary hardship in the way of carrying out the strict letter of this Local Law, then the owner of said property may apply to the Town Board of the Town in writing for a variance from strict compliance with this Local Law upon submission of proof of such unnecessary hardship.

Section 6. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20____ of the City of _____ having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of section (36)(37) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the (special)(general) election held on _____ 20____, became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

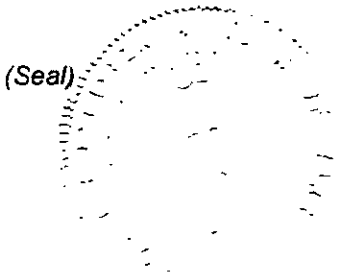
