## **COCKATOO**

1965



Wow - this week I have LITTLE to say about the weekly reissued souvenir (that's saying something for a patent lawyer!) But not because there isn't much to say about the **COCKATOO**, but because we are not certain as to its original use!

We've whittled down the likely possibilities to any one of four locations (perhaps in this order of possibility): (1) PARROT JUNGLE, Florida; (2) FLORIDA TURNPIKE; (3) The 2nd year of the NEW YORK WORLD'S FAIR at the FLORIDA PAVILION; or (4) BUSCH GARDENS, Florida.

PARROT JUNGLE was a zoological park located south of Miami, founded in 1936. PARROT JUNGLE is perhaps by elimination the most likely location that the **COCKATOO** was custom made for. But right now it's just a guess - I have no evidence. There WERE machines located at PARROT JUNGLE long ago though, and at least at a later time the **COCKATOO** was vended there. Perhaps it was back in 1965 as well. (Full disclosure: that is my mom on the right, and my grandmother in the photo on the left!)



I have no information that the **COCKATOO** was even run at a FLORIDA TURNPIKE location. But it just seems like a possibility.



While the Florida Pavilion of the 1965 New York World's Fair seems like a good possiblity, I know of no COCKATOO with such engraving. Also, the moldset numbering at 1164 places it a bit late in 1965 (if not 1966). It should be noted that the PARROT JUNGLE took its trained COCKATOO to the New York World's Fair. But my fantastic friend who worked for Mold-A-Rama at the New York World's Fair tells me that he didn't see the COCKATOO at the Florida Pavilion (or anywhere at the NYWF). (He DID say that the ALLIGATOR was run at the Florida Pavilion though!) As a result, I think it's probably UNlikely that the COCKATOO was originally vended at the NYWF.

There are known vintage **COCKATOO** molds fancy, original-seeming engraving from Busch Gardens, but it is believed that the mold machines weren't installed at Busch Gardens until the late 1960s-early 1970s.





The **COCKATOO** moldset is numbered 1164, which places it in 1965, but almost late in 1965. The **COCKATOO** that Club-A-Rama members will receive is engraved "TAMPA LOWRY PARK ZOO". The **COCKATOO** has also been run at Sunken Gardens, and at Sarasota Jungle Gardens.
