

#### Liaison Committee

The Liaison Committee met on May 4, 2021 Topics discussed were:

Movement to the cloud based system. A demo of this system will be available to local health soon. Partial suspension of routine inspections is still in place. Transition to google for those who are part of the ".gov" system. Primitive camp grounds and waste disposal. Permitting mobile food vendors. OLS is starting to look into Legionella testing. RTIA has found some elevated lead levels in several homes and the engineering division is following up. WVAS is looking for people to run for office. Kearneysville District Sanitarian position is open. OEHS will be posting a position located in Charleston that will work with both the food and sewage programs.

### LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The legislative session ran from January 13– April 10, 2021.

The following environmental health related issues were introduced and passed: **HB 2427 relating to dogs in bars.** There was an emergency filing of 64CSR17 Food Establishment Rule due to bill being passed that allowed for a companion dog in an establishment that is a private club, brewpub, or microdistillery.
