**Hello Elk Members,**

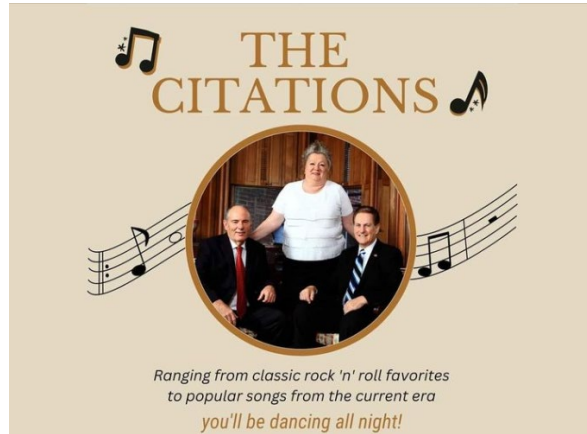
