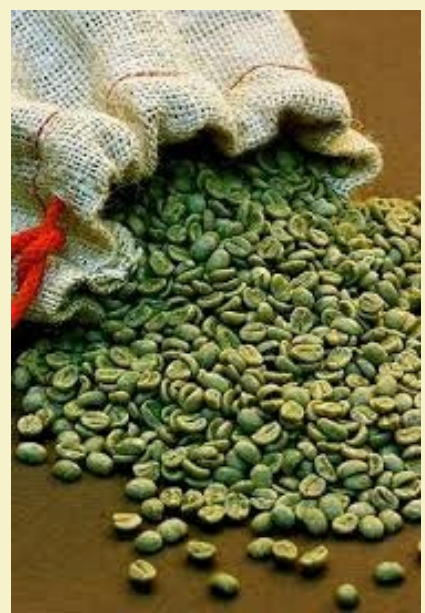

Recipe: Pears Baked in KonAroma



Dry Ingredients:

- 4 Bartlett Pears, halved and cored
- 1 Cinnamon stick
- 1 Cup KonAroma
- ¼ Cup Light Brown Sugar
- ½ Tsp Vanilla Extract

Instructions:

- Heat the oven to 375 degrees
- Tuck cinnamon stick among pears in baking dish
- Pour in ¾ cup of coffee and sprinkle brown sugar evenly over pears
- Bake for 35 minutes continually basting
- Remove dish from the oven and add the vanilla, tilting the pan to mix in
- Discard cinnamon stick
- Serve warm, topped with whipped cream, ice cream, or creme fraiche
