  - Turkey costs
    - Joe @ HEB--he does strictly turkey breast, \$8/lb with an estimated serving size of 6-7 oz per person. For 150 people, it would be \$540. Does this number sound doable? Someone would need to take him 3-5 coolers ahead of time, and he would have the turkey breast sliced, in foil pans, wrapped and warm for us to just set out. Someone would need to pick it up around 4:30.
    - Sam's Smoked Turkeys - \$2.99 a pound (between \$150-\$175 for 150 people) This would be much less expensive, but we would then need volunteers to at the very least heat the turkeys up and either carve them up at the feast or carve them up ahead of time and keep them warm in crock pots.
    - Jed is going to smoke a turkey; booster will purchase that, an additional turkey, and two hams for other volunteers to prepare
