# **Proposed Constitution Change**

Historically, the originating source of many recommended proposed constitutional changes and congregational votes has been brought forth by the Sharon Leadership Team. During the last special members meeting, a motion was brought forth (and passed by majority vote) by the present members for the SLT to bring forth an affiliation vote after the closure of ACA hosted at SMC. The following proposal is under no circumstances a reflection of the thoughts and beliefs of the elders, either for or against. By prayerfully bringing this motion forward for congregational consideration, the SLT is fulfilling the commitment and obligation to the wishes of the congregation.

#### **Preamble**

Presently, Sharon Mennonite Church is affiliated with Mennonite Church USA and Ohio Mennonite Conference.

### **Proposed Constitutional Change:**

Whereas Mennonite Church USA has altered their interpretation of the Confession of Faith in a Mennonite Perspective 1995, Sharon Mennonite Church, following its constitution's guidelines for a 2/3 majority affirmative vote\*, hereby decides to:

Retain affiliation with Ohio Mennonite Conference and dissolve affiliation with Mennonite Church USA, including the cessation of financial contributions to Mennonite Church USA through Ohio Mennonite Conference.

Yes, I agree to disassociate with Mennonite Church USA. No, I prefer to remain associated with Mennonite Church USA.

## \*Sharon Mennonite Church Constitution - Article IX. Members' Meetings Section 3. Quorum

A quorum for annual and special Members' Meetings shall be members present.

### **Section 4. Amendments**

This Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of those present at a Members' Meeting, provided that the said amendment had been previously approved by the Finance and Facilities Council and public announcement of the same had been made at least two Sundays prior to the time of meeting. Voting on all amendments shall be by ballot.
