1. Call to order

2. Roll call

Allan Kuehl, Diane Shultz, Mike Null, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol; all present, you have a quorum. Barbara Thomas and Anthony Campbell not present.

Invocation was given by Glenda Pennington, City Clerk

6. Adopt Agenda

Mayor Allan Kuehl asked for motion to adopt the agenda with the addition of city wide clean up and presentation from Kenny Warnol. Motion was made by Trevor Warnol, seconded by Mary Wiles. Roll call vote: Diane Shultz, Mike Null, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol. Motion carried 4-0

Motion was made by Trevor Warnol to adopt the agenda with the city wide clean up and the presentation from Kenny Warnol, seconded by Diane Shultz; roll call vote: Diane Shultz, Mike Null, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol; motion carried 4-0

7. Approve Minutes

Motion was made by Trevor Warnol to approve the minutes for March 24, 2020, seconded by Mary Wiles; roll call vote: Mike Null, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol, Diane Shultz accused herself for not being present. Motion carried 3-1

Motion was made by Diane Shultz to approve and ratify the bills, seconded by Trevor Warnol; roll call vote: Diane Shultz, Mike Null, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol; motion carried 4-0

Discussion about having a workshop on amending the budget for the 6 month period. Mayor Allan Kuehl advised that city wide spring clean up will be April 20 – April 24, 2020. WCA will put a 30-yard dumpster down at the old maintenance building. Kenny Warnol will have someone down there from 8am to 10am on Tuesday and Thursday to help and make sure the residents put things in the right spot and the right things.

Presentation by Kenny Warnol giving a run down on the projects they have been doing, parts that they have ordered, etc. Mary Wiles asked about shirts for maintenance workers. Kenny Warnol advised that they had them, they were in the washer and dryer down at the

treatment plant. Mayor Allan Kuehl advised that Marshall Gary Brankel was going to make ID badges for them to wear.

8. NEW BUSINESS:

Mike Null asked Mayor Allan Kuehl explain a little more about the Ordinance. Mayor Allan Kuehl advised that it gave the police the legal ability to disperse groups of 10 or more people. Trevor Warnol advised that it was against his beliefs and he disagreed with the Ordinance. Mayor Allan Kuehl read Ordinance 580 then after reading it was reminded that you have a motion and a vote to read before you read the Ordinance. Motion was made by Diane Shultz to read the Ordinance. Mayor Allan Kuehl read the ordinance with no vote. Motion was made by Diane Shultz to read the Ordinance a second time with no vote. Motion was made by Diane Shultz to adopt Ordinance 580. No one seconded the motion; Ordinance 580 died.
