1. CALL TO ORDER:

A quorum being present the council meeting of the Dixon City Council was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Jeff Clark

3. APPROVE MARCH MINUTIES

A motion was made by Betty McPherson and seconded by Steven Parker to approve the March 2014 Council Minutes. All Alderman present voting aye, the motion carried.

4. APPROVE AND RATIFY BILLS RECEIVED IN MARCH

A motion was made by Steven Parker and seconded by Travis Rollins to approve the March 2014 Council. All Alderman present voting aye, the motion carried.

5. OPEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

Marie Toothman

She made a statement that she called the Police department some time back And the Police Department would never answer the phone.

6. NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion on updating the printer in the City Clerk's office so it's more Proficient to work for both City Clerk and City Collectors office.

A motion was made by Betty McPherson and seconded by Travis Rollins to approve to purchase a printer from Corporate Business systems for 1,766.25 All Alderman present voting aye, the motion carried.

City Code 210.290 Discussion about service charge of \$35.00 to turn the Water off and back on. This would prevent tampering with the City shut Off valve. This was tabled until April 21 2014 for some research.

7. POLICE REPORT:

Mike Plummer went over the Police Report.

Mike Plummer addresses the City Council about possibly getting an account with SAM's.

A motion was made by Paul Watson and seconded by Steven Parker to approve the Credit limit at Sam's for 1200. Per month. All Alderman present voting aye, the motion carried.

8. CITY MAINTENANCE REPORT:

Dennis went over the maintenance report and said that after repairs of the old trash truck it too is up and running. Dennis stated that said it looks like we're going to spend a little more money on street than we had planned... when we get a string of nice warm day's we'er going digging up and fixing.

Jeff Clark said that the roads are bad now; they are going to get way worse. Horrendously worse, before they get better.... It doesn't make sense to pave while infrastructure underneath needs to be fixed.

9. CITY ENGINEER REPORT:

John Doyle stated said in most cases, the sewer work will take about three days to get through each person's yard, but it doesn't include backfill work. It will probably come back after the first rain. If we get a call from you after first rain saying it settled the ditch fallen in, come back we probably will.

John Doyle said that repair near the school will be scheduled during the summer to try to avoid bus problems.

John Doyle said people in Dixon need to be aware, there will be open trenches, but will not be left overnight, just being careful.

John Doyle said that he will take calls from citizens regarding problems but would like them to go through City Hall.

John Doyle stated that people do take care of their yards, and we want leave it like that.

John Doyle said that the contractors warranty applies to pipes, not asphalt. I don't want to go out and dig up new asphalt just because we missed a connection to find the connection... I want to leave it rough... after a year we are going to know if there is a problem.

John Doyle said the current sewer project is probably Dixon's largest-ever public works project. You did a storm water project in the 80's this will far surpass that.
