1. Call to order

2. Roll call

Allan Kuehl, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Mike Null, Diane Shultz present; Barbara Thomas, Trevor Warnol absent. There is a quorum.

Diane Shultz made a motion to adopt the agenda, seconded by Mike Null; roll call vote: Anthony Campbell, Mary Miles, Mike Null, Diane Shultz, motion carried 4-0

7. New Business:

Discussion on the printers in City Hall and Police Department. Price of toner to operate them. Mayor Kuehl introduced Mark from MARCO. Mark gave a presentation on printers, fax machines, scanners, prices, parts not available, maintenance not included for the old machines. Explained the difference between the printer for City Hall and for the Police Department. Their proposal includes toner for all, maintenance for all. We pay for pieces printed and rental fee. Black copies are .008 per piece compared to .03 per piece; color is .05 per piece printed. Professional installation and training at no additional cost. Discussed the fire wall protection for the Police Department.

Diane Shultz made a motion to enter into the lease agreement with MARCO for a 5 year term; seconded by Mike Null; roll call vote: Diane Shultz, Mike Null, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles; motion carried 4-0

Mark mentioned since the vote was done and it passed that there is a rebate for \$500.00 to the city but he is trying to make that \$1,000.00. Mark didn't want to say anything about the rebate before the vote because he didn't want that to influence the sale or vote.

8. Old Business:

Discussion on medical marijuana ordinance. Also discussing the security personnel, training, etc. Security is just for observation and secure the building. All employees will have access to only areas where they work. Cameras everywhere where there is product. Dr. Kim from the Dixon Family Practice is able to write prescriptions. Once they are written, in they go to the dispensary and you have to log into DHS website and scan all information. DHS and Mules (Police Departments computer program) will work together for information. Most popular age is 55+. Council will be able a walk through before any plants are put into the facility. If you are a patient you can grow in your own house with no restrictions as to how far from Church's, schools, day cares, etc.
