In the month of July: 334 calls of service, 12 Agency Assists, 79 phone calls, 2 unresponsive/unconscious (no overdoses), 17 suspicious activities, 10 paper services, 26 walk-ins and 29 well-being checks.

Sludge truck was purchased for parts to repair the existing the truck. Pat presented the council with a bid of \$3,682 for an alarm to put on his phone that will alert him when the High School well goes down. The council asked for the alarm to be scheduled for implementation in October.
