Motion was made by Diane Shultz to table the discussion on Steve Browns alley for further investigation until the next meeting; seconded by Mary Wiles; roll call vote: Anthony Campbell, Barbara Thomas, Mary Wiles, Diane Shultz; motion carried 4-0**

**Discussion on Doyle Braddums water bill and granddaughters' water bill. Granddaughter moved in 7 years ago. Was asked to have water turned off at end of June but got a bill for July. The Braddums asked to have it deleted and the Braddums got a bill for the same residence that they paid. Motion was made by Barbara Thomas to eliminate the Garrett & Elexia Dean bill, reference number 1297001 because of clerical error; seconded by Anthony Campbell; roll call vote: Anthony Campbell, Barbara Thomas, Mary Wiles, Diane Shultz; motion carried 4-0**
