9. SALVATION ARMY BELL-RINGING

Mike Gunther will be coordinating the Bell-ringing for the City of Dixon. Mr. Gunther pointed out how important that this fund raiser is for the community. Dixon donated \$7,500 last year and received almost \$15,000 in services provided to the residence of Dixon. The Red Kettles will be set up starting Monday November 28, and continue until December 24th. Individuals and Organizations wishing to Ring a Bell can sign up at City Hall in addition to contracting Mr. Gunther directly.

10. ROBERT BAILEY NUISANCE VIOLATIONS

11. POLICE UPDATE
