TJ had said they are 52 nuisance violations they are currently working on. TJ presented to the council about needing extra tazors, new carrier vests, and new armor bulletproof vest. The intention for getting these items are so all officers have

their own equipment. The carrier vest will get the weight off the hips and more on the shoulder area. The tazors will be an asset as the officers are using ones from 1997. The police department currently only has 3 tazors. TJ presented to the council the benefits of each items the police department was asking for. Mayor and council members liked the idea of the new equipment if it was in the budget. Renovations on the police department were discussed. Council agreed if the budget allowed it then \$20,000.00 can go for renovating the police department.

RESOLUTION NO. 22- 001

**A RESOLUTION OF PULASKI COUNTY, MISSOURI, CALLING
FOR SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS BY ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF IMPOSING A
CAPITOL IMPROVEMENTS SALES TAX**

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Pulaski County, Missouri, proposes to enact, upon approval of a majority of the votes cast on the proposal by the qualified voters voting thereon in favor of, a capital improvements sales tax, as authorized by Section 67.700 RSMo, to provide for funding of building, improving, and maintaining bridges and roadways in the County of Pulaski. In addition, should this tax be approved by the voters, then the County Commission intends to phase out and eliminate the personal property tax levied for County Roadways.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
PULASKI COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The following question shall be put before the voters of Pulaski County at the primary election to be held on April 5, 2022, on the following question:

QUESTION

Shall the County of Pulaski impose a countywide sales tax at the rate of one half of one percent in perpetuity from the date on which such tax is first imposed for the purpose of building, improving, and maintaining bridges and roadways in the County of Pulaski.

YES NO

If you are in favor of the question, place an "X" in the box opposite "YES". If you are opposed to the question, place an "X" in the box opposite "NO"

Section 2. The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to conduct said election in a manner consistent with the Revised Statutes of Missouri, including Chapter 115.

Section 3. The County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to notify the Pulaski County Clerk's Office, the Election Authority of Pulaski County, Missouri, of the passage of this Resolution and to include in said notification all of the terms and provisions required by Chapter 115 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended.

Section 4. If said countywide sales tax shall pass, then one year from the effective date of the imposition of the countywide sales tax, the County of Pulaski shall phase out collection of the Road and Bridge Personal Property Tax at a rate of 25% of the taxable amount per year until the Road and Bridge Property Tax rate reaches zero and at which time it shall remain at zero.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



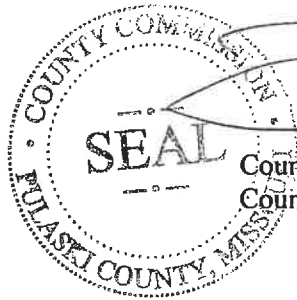
