1. CALL TO ORDER

5. ADOPT THE AGENDA

8. DONATIONS TO THE CITY/TAX EXEMPT

Jeff Thomas will research the procedure for people to donate items and/or money to the City and will follow-up with the Council.

9. LIBRARY – WIFI/SECURITY SYSTEM

Mayor Null reported the library had been broken into and the money bag and camera system was stolen. Council made a phone call with Shane Sweno to discuss the need for a security system that will send photos to an off-site location. Shane explained to council what he recommended to install. He will follow-up with a price to install a camera system.

10. LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT OPPORTUNITY

Kelli Livengood informed the Council about a grant opportunity to improve recreational areas in the city. The grant has a maximum of \$500,000 with a minimum 50% match from the City. Draft applications may be submitted for a courtesy review by the Grants Management staff by October 19, 2022. Final applications must be postmarked by November 16, 2022. Council will bring ideas for projects to the next meeting.

11. PERSONNEL POLICY

Kelli Livengood presented the Council with the revised personnel policy. Mayor Null advised Council to send Ms. Livengood changes and/or edits by the next council meeting.

12. EMPLOYEE PERFORMANCE REVIEW

Kelli Livengood provided a copy of the evaluation tool for Council to review. The existing evaluation tool was deemed appropriate. Evaluations are due in October for all City employees.

13. POLICE UPDATE – RADIO QUOTES

Officer Durbin provided quotes from RCS and Warner for six new radios and a repeater for the City. Anthony Campbell made the motion to purchase the Warner Communications Repeater for \$8,411.57, Mary Wiles seconded the motion. 15. PHONE ISSUES

Deanna Burns explained the issues with the phone system at the City Hall, Library and Police Department. The current phone system will not allow lines to be transferred or answered at times. Chief Halle reported that the dispatch phone doesn't ring and will circle back to the initial greeting back numerous times. Ms. Burns shared the quote to get new 12 new phones. Stacey Yoakum made the motion to approve the purchase of 12 new phones for the City Hall, Police Department and Library up to \$2,700, Mary Wiles seconded the motion.
