1. **CALL TO ORDER**
Meeting called to order at 6:10PM
2. **ROLL CALL**
Mike Null, Stacey Yoakum, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol.
(Quorum 4-0)
3. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**
(All present stood for Pledge.)
4. **INVOCATION**
(No one gave invocation.)
5. **ADOPT THE AGENDA**
Motion was made by Mary Wiles to adopt the agenda, was seconded by Anthony Campbell. Roll Call to vote; Stacey Yoakum, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol.
(Motion carried 4-0)
6. **RATIFY BILLS**
Motion was made by Mary Wiles to approve bills, was seconded by Anthony Campbell. Roll Call to vote; Stacey Yoakum, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol.
(Motion carried 4-0)
7. **APPROVE MINUTES**
Motion was made by Trevor Warnol to approve the minutes from July 20, 2021 meeting, was seconded by Stacey Yoakum. Roll Call to vote; Stacey Yoakum, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol. Anthony Campbell abstained from vote because he wasn't in attendance at the July 20th meeting. (Motion carried 3-0)

8. CHIEF OF POLICE

Motion was made by Mary Wiles to appoint officer Timothy G. Halle, Jr. as chief of police, this motion was seconded by Anthony Campbell. Roll Call to vote; Stacey Yoakum, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol.
(Motion carried 4-0)

After motion was voted on, honorable Judge Les Hansmann swore officer Halle into office as he took oath.

9. RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE BIDS

Trevor Warnol made a motion to accept the bid and enter into a 3-year contract with GFL for residential solid waste, Stacey Yoakum seconded the motion. Roll Call to vote; Stacey Yoakum, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol. Anthony Campbell voted no.

10. MISSOURI BICENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

As of now, the Missouri bicentennial celebration is still in effect. The city will be serving ice cream in the park on August 10, 2021 unless something changes or the chamber cancels the event.

11. NEW BUSINESS LICENSES

Mini Excavator -Mayor Null discussed briefly how the city needs to start looking at bids to buy or lease a mini excavator to work on the street ditches. Will re-group in the future.

Street Improvements- Mayor Null talked about how the city is going to start improving some of the streets again soon. He asked the public if they had any input on what streets were really bad and needed to have attention brought to them. He instructed citizens to please contact the city with street names if so.

(Motion carried 4-0)


14. OPEN SESSION @6:45PM


