1. CALL TO ORDER
Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.
2. ROLL CALL
Mike Null (Mayor), Stacey Yoakum, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol,
Quorum (4-0)
3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
(All present stood for Pledge.)
4. INVOCATION
No invocation was given.
5. ADOPT THE AGENDA
Stacey Yoakum made a motion to adopt the agenda, Trevor Warnol seconded the motion.

6. RATIFY BILLS
Mary Wiles asked for clarification regarding the purchase of 15 firearms. Chief Halle reported that he has 11 officers (see clarification of number in Police update below) and that 4 of the firearms have been allocated to officers. Mayor Null advised the proper way to distribute the guns to officers.

Stacey Yoakum gave a report to the top three projects:
 - 1) Enhancing Park Security;
 - 2) Expanding Existing Sidewalks – High School across Hwy 28, through the business district to Country Mart; and
 - 3) Track at Shepard’s Park
12. ANNEXATION LOTS 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 in BLOCK 8 OF THE LION’S CLUB ADDITION
The annexation will take place July 5, 2022 and the legal notice will be in the Dixon Pilot this week.
13. MIKE PARSONS – STRAY AND LOOSE DOGS
Mike Parsons brought concerns regarding the problem with stray and loose dogs. Citizens should contact the PD if problems occur. The City of Dixon has a Dog Registration and Licensing ordinance (Ord No. 568). Each dog tag is \$15 per year per dog and is renewable on January 1 of each year. A reminder will be posted in the paper and on Facebook.
14. CODE BOOK AND HANDBOOK WORKSHOP – NEED TO SET DATES
Handbook workshop is tentatively set for Tuesday, June 14 at 6pm.
15. CITY OF DIXON WEBSITE
Kelli Livengood gave a report of the website she has created for the City of Dixon. The website is active but is waiting for a domain. She asked that council members view the website and give her feedback. The site is www.cityofdixon.wixsite.com/website. Kelli shared that she added the ability to pay utilities and court fees through the website, as well

as, fillable forms such as Utility Service Agreement, Dog Registration, Business License and General Build Permit. It was suggested to add contact emails for the Mayor and Chief of Police.

16. POLICE UPDATE

Chief Halle reported 265 calls for service. He also provided a clarification that he has 8 paid officers; 3 full-time and 5 part-time with a few of those being reserves which means they are only paid if they are on the schedule. Mary Wiles made a suggestion to track calls and occurrences.

17. MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Pat Ragan reported work on Sixth Street between Locust and Elm. The quote is around \$15,000 to replace water lines and sewer lines with additional equipment costing \$3,000. Rock is also needed. Council asked for a more accurate price and quote for the project.

18. MML CONFERENCE JUNE 9-10 COLUMBIA ELECTED OFFICIALS

Deanna Burns reminded council of the upcoming conference. She has a packet for those interested in attending.

20. OPEN SESSION @ 7:45 P.M.


