1. **CALL TO ORDER**
Meeting called to order at 6:01PM
2. **ROLL CALL**
Mike Null -Mayor, Stacey Yoakum, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol.

3. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

4. **INVOCATION**
No invocation was given.
5. **ADOPT THE AGENDA**
Motion was made by Trevor Warnol to adopt the agenda and was seconded by Anthony Campbell. Roll call to vote; Stacey Yoakum, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol.

6. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

8. NUISANCE/ COLLECTIONS/ ORDINANCE #590

In attempt to collect nuisance fees and past collections, the city has put an ordinance in place that states after all attempts are made by the city to collect monies owed, the city can then reach out to the county collector for help.

10. LION'S CLUB PARK UPDATE

Statement about Lion's Club Park was given and read by Lana Wilson. Lana and the council discussed what ownership and name rights the city and the lion's club had on the park and why/when things came about. *"See attachment"

Council and lion's member also talked about possible grant opportunities to help improve the park equipment.

11. PHONE/INTERNET PROVIDER

12. RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE PROPOSAL

Ad was posted in the paper that we are seeking proposals on a new waste disposal company. M&M Roll off had responded that they aren't interested because they don't have enough carts to supply the city with. We haven't gotten any other proposals at this time.

13. MO RURAL WATER VIRTUAL TRAINING

Mary Wiles and Stacey Yoakum gave brief update about the MO Rural Water virtual training courses.

14. GWORKS FRONT DESK UPDATE

Council was presented information about Gworks Front Desk client and how it has multiple benefits such as Texting/Electronic Notifications for utility customers. It also offers Online/Electronic/and auto payment. The cost of this is \$1200.00 a year and has a discounted start up fee of \$800.00 currently until the end of June. This is usually a \$3000 start up fee.
