9. MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Daniel provided the council with estimate for a side-by-side purchase. The council reviewed and discussed it amongst themselves and with Daniel. Some of them are looking into different options/vendors and told Daniel to check back on a few options as well. Will discuss again in the future, no definite decision made at this time.

10. 10<sup>TH</sup> STREET CULVERT PROJECT

When the electric company was doing some right of way clearing, there were 3 water pipes that became exposed near 10<sup>th</sup> street approximately 16-17 foot in length. The council discussed the urgency of getting them covered back up correctly so that they are no longer exposed, and getting an access made so that the PD can patrol that area of town. The council approved a max of \$8,000 to get this project completed in a timely manner.

12. OPEN SESSION @6:50PM


