2. Roll call

5. Adopt Agenda

6. Approve Minutes

7. NEW BUSINESS:

Motion was made to approve Business license for Leo's Mexican Restaurant, Rustic Shanty, Sam's Custom Concrete, F&S Demolition and Excavation made by Mary Wiles, seconded by Trevor Warnol; roll call vote: Mike Null, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol; Diane Shultz voted no; motion carried 4-1

Discussion on snowplow truck (F350) for maintenance for \$14,000.00. Motion was made Anthony Campbell to approve it's purchase, seconded by Mary Wiles; roll call vote: Mike Null, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol, Diane Shultz voted no; motion carried 4-1

Discussion on putting a bid out for the Tahoe (old Police vehicle). Motion was made by Trevor Warnol to put it up for bid, seconded by Anthony Campbell; roll call vote: Mike Null, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol, Diane Shultz voted no; motion carried 4-1

Discussion on plans for the new City Hall. Diane Shultz brought up concerns about cables for the computers and land lines. Motion was made by Trevor Warnol to advertise for bids for 10 days. All bids must be received by 12 noon on November 23, 2020. Council will meet at 6:00pm that day to open bids. Motion was seconded by Mary Wiles; roll call vote: Mike Null, Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles, Trevor Warnol, Diane Shultz voted no; motion carried 4-1

Concerns were brought up by a citizen about the people coming in and out for Court. Les Hannsman (the Judge) advised him that the Supreme Court ruling that masks are not required but still have to do social distancing and no more then 10 people in at a time, not counting the one's associated with court.
