
"I was still 17 [when I entered the host home program.] ... I didn't have any local identification or connections ... I was able to visit with them at their home, to see the home first . They gave me a tour. I was able to go to lunch with them and have a conversation with them and get a feel for them before I was expected to just move in with these strangers. And you feel more like a person involved in your own life than a peg looking to be put into a slot. I went from that [homelessness] to not only being on firmer footing but being in a village, feeling like I was in a village of supportive involved people... who I could actually be involved with and support, as well."

Qamar was a youth participant in the GLBT Host Home Program at Avenues for Homeless Youth in MN, which has served as a model and guide for COR's host home program. We can't wait to share homegrown success stories as queer Alaskan youth move from homelessness into safe stable homes with supportive communities and full involvement in their own lives!

Amber was finishing her senior year of high school when her stepfather kicked her out. She had been accepted to college and would be living in a dorm that fall; she just had to survive the next six months. That night, she walked through downtown Anchorage, trying to think of anywhere she could go. As a transwoman, she feared for her safety in a shelter environment.

Kaden's family of origin mistreated him because he was different. He bounced from foster home to foster home. When he ended up homeless as a queer teenager, he didn't find the available sheltering systems to be safe or supportive of his identity. He struggled with suicidality and with substance abuse.

These stories reflect the harsh realities and limited options LGBTQ+ youth can face. Due to your support, COR is changing this reality, offering new hope and options to young Alaskans like Amber and Kaden.

We are so pleased to share with you COR's first annual Community Report. Understand that your generosity has an impact. 
