

ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
SPENCER, MEDINA CO., OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
SPENCER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. Whoever sells or permits to be consumed on the premises at any place of business in the Village of Spencer, beer or other malt beverages, wines, prepared highballs, cocktails or other mixed drinks as defined in the Amended Liquor Control Act, or any intoxicating liquors during week days and Sundays after the hour of 11:00 o'clock P. M. untill 5:30 o'clock A. M. the following morning, or on Saturday night 12:00 o'clock P. M. to 5:30 o'clock A. M. the following morning, shall be fined for each offense not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and imprisonment for not less than five days and not more than thirty days. The holder of a liquor permit issued by the Department of Liquor Control shall be no excuse for the violation of this ordinance. The intoxicating liquors and beer herein shall be defined by the Liquor Control Act of Ohio.

SECTION II. This Ordinance also prohibits the playing of pool in any public place between the hours of 12:00 o'clock P. M. and 5:30 o'clock A. M. on week days and further prohibits the playing of pool and cards between the hours of 12:00 o'clock P. M. Saturday night and 5:30 o'clock A. M. Monday morning in any public place and shall be fined for each offense not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

SECTION III. That all ordinances and provisions of ordinances inconsistent herewith and contrary to this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
