

ORDINANCE NO. 9

TO VACATE A PORTION OF MADISON STREET IN THE
VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO.

WHEREAS, all of the owners of property abutting
on Madison Street from the south line of Brown's Second
Addition to the right-of-way of the Northern Ohio Rail-
road Company, have filed with the Council a written co-
nsent to have such portion of Madison Street vacated,
and by reason thereof no notice of the proposal to vac-
ate such portion of such street is necessary, and

WHEREAS, the vacation of such portion of such street
will not be detrimental to general or public interests,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the
Village of Spencer, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Madison Street from the south line
of Brown's Second Addition northerly to the right-of-way
of the Northern Ohio Railway Company shall be, and is
hereby, vacated.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from the
earliest period allowed by law.
