

ORDINANCE NO. 198

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
SPENCER, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, PROVIDING FOR TIME AND PLACE  
FOR REGULAR MEETINGS OF COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Medina County,  
Ohio:

SECTION 1: Regular meetings of the Spencer Village Council shall  
henceforth, commencing with the February, 1968, meeting,  
be held on the fourth Thursday of each month.

SECTION 2: All meetings shall convene at 7:30 o'clock P.M. and  
shall be held in Town Hall, or at such other place as the  
Mayor, by proper action, may indicate.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared and determined to be  
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation  
of the public peace and welfare of the Village of Spencer in  
that the same provides rules for the proper regular meetings  
of the legislative authority, and, provided it receive the  
requisite vote as an emergency measure, shall go into immed-  
iate operation and effect, otherwise it shall go into full  
force and effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
