

ORDINANCE NO. 132

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW PERIOD FROM 9:30 O'CLOCK P.M. TO 5:00 O'CLOCK A.M. DAILY FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS

WHEREAS THE Council of the Village of Spencer has determined that it would be in the best interests of the preservation of public property and the public peace to establish a curfew period during which no persons under the age of eighteen (18) years shall be allowed upon the streets or sidewalks of the Village of Spencer, unless accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian or custodian,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer:

Section I. That there shall be and hereby is established a curfew period between the hours of 9:30 o'clock P.M. and 5:00 o'clock A.M. daily to be effective from the date of this ordinance ~~to and through~~ ~~November 1954~~, during which hours no person being under the age of eighteen (18) years shall be allowed upon the streets or sidewalks of the Village of Spencer unless accompanied by his or her parent or legal Guardian or custodian.

Section II. That it shall be a misdemeanor for any person to violate the provision of this ordinance and every person convicted or found guilty of a misdemeanor for a violation of the provisions of this act shall be fined for not more than \$25.00.

Section III That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace and shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
