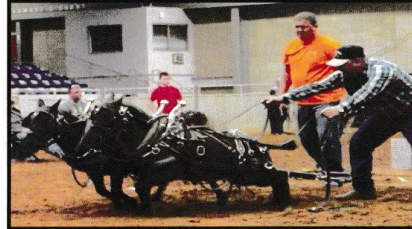

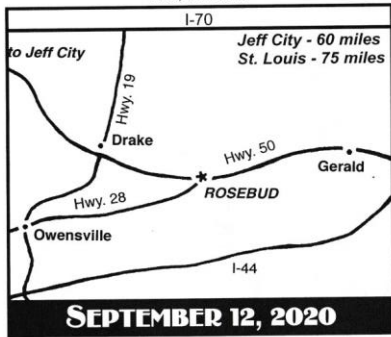

# 2020 ANTIQUE TRACTOR PULL RULES AND REGULATIONS

**EVERYONE IS REQUIRED TO PAY AT GATE • NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE CHARGED TO PULL TRACTOR**

**Ozark Highlanders Association** Revised 3/2020  
**2020 General Rules & Regulations**

1. Tractors 1959 and continuous.
2. All Hooks are \$15.
3. Any tractor or puller found to be unsafe or illegal may be disqualified or barred from hooking. No alcoholic beverage will be permitted on track while pulling.
4. Tire sizes are as follows: No radial tires. No cut or shaved tires.

0-5000 lbs. 170 sq. in. Max	5001-6500 lbs. 229 sq. in. Max	7000-7500 250 sq. in. Max	8000 lbs. Up
13.6 x 38-168 sq. in.	14.9 x 38-200 sq. in.	16.9 x 38-252 sq. in.	OPEN
14.9 x 28-170 sq. in.	15.5 x 38-189 sq. in.	18.4 x 34-284 sq. in.	
	16.9 x 34-229 sq. in.	18.4 x 28-250 sq. in.	

5. Tractors weigh with driver. There is a 20 lbs. allowance.
6. All tractors must weigh in with signed up driver before each pull.
7. Twenty percent (20%) RPM allowance over factory settings.
8. Weights:
  - Max of 11 feet from center of rear axle to further most point.
  - Rear weights are not to exceed past the real wheel.
  - A 12 - inch window in the center required to aid hooking and unhooking.
9. All tractors **MUST** be original in appearance. Non factory air filters will be allowed.
10. Tractors may pull in first or second gear only.
11. Drawbar must not exceed twenty one (21) inches in height or less than eighteen (18) inches from center of rear axle to hooking point.
12. Pull is ended by one of the following:
  - Flagman.
  - Driver does not remain seated, or have at least one hand on wheel.
  - Anything falls off tractor and hits the track.
  - Tractor or sled gets out of the track.
  - All forward motion of tractor and/or sled stops.
13. Tractor may pull once per class.
14. Tractors may pull in 2 weight classes. 3 classes depending on track conditions & time allowed.
15. No excessive jerking of sled.
16. No shifting of torque amplifier during pull.
17. If you contest a tractor, it must be in your class during your pull in that class. Protester must be checked first.
18. All pullers will pull in order they register. Mechanical breakdown or weight changes will move tractor to end of the class. If then unable to pull, tractor is disqualified.
19. Puller has two attempts of make pull. Any distance of 25 feet will be counted as a valid pull.
20. Track judges or committee members of Ozark Highlanders has the right to disqualify any tractor.  
**Their decision will be final.**
21. 3.5 MPH speed limit. Pull ends once horn sounds after front of sled passes a 75 foot marker.
  - 5 MPH speed limit for 8000 lbs. or more.
22. Sled operator, hook man, flagger, weigh master make up track committee and reserves the right to protest any tractor.
23. There is no changing classes once the first hook of the pull is hooked.
24. Only driver and 1 coach may be on the track during the pull.
25. All drivers must be able to safely operate tractor unassisted.

**2020 Top Cut Class Rules & Regulations**

1. All Top Cut Classes must abide by General Rules & Regulations unless specific to Top Cut Class listed below
2. All Hooks are \$15
3. Tractors 1959 and Continuous.
4. Top Cut Tractors cannot run in classes other than Top Cut Classes.
5. All Top Cut Tractors Must have wheelie bars. If you do not have wheelie bars, you will be disqualified. Wheelie bars must support the weight of the tractor.
6. Drawbar must not exceed twenty (20) inches in height or less than eighteen (18) inches from center of rear axle

- to hooking point.
7. Tractors may be pulled in any gear.
8. No shifting of torque amplifier during pull.
9. Tractors will have a 4 MPH Speed Limit.
10. Twenty percent (20%) RPM allowance over factory settings.
11. Max Tire size calculation of 69 is determined by the following formula. (Tire Width X 2) + Tire Diameter.
12. Max Tire size in Top Cut Classes are 15.5X38, 16.9X34-16" max rim width.
13. Stock sheet metal and hoods. Stock wheel base.
14. **Div. TC** tractors can pull in up to 2 weight classes as they choose. (One hook per class.)
15. All tractors must weigh in with signed up driver before each pull.
16. Top Cut Weight Classes are: 3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000, 6500.

**2020 Full Cut Class Rules & Regulations 4 MPH & 6 MPH Classes**

1. All Full Cut Classes must abide by General Rules & Regulations unless specific to Full Cut Class listed below
2. All Hooks are \$15
3. Tractors 1959 and Continuous.
4. Full Cut Tractors cannot run in classes other than Full Cut Classes.
5. All Full Cut Tractors Must have wheelie bars. If you do not have wheelie bars, you will be disqualified. Wheelie bars must support the weight of the tractor.
6. Drawbar must not exceed twenty (20) inches in height or less than eighteen (18) inches from center of rear axle to hooking point.
7. Tractors may be pulled in any gear.
8. No shifting of torque amplifier during pull.
9. Tractors will have a 6 MPH Speed Limit.
10. Twenty percent (20%) RPM allowance over factory settings.
11. Max Tire size calculation of 74.8 is determined by the following formula. (Tire Width X 2) + Tire Diameter.
12. Max Tire size in Full Cut Classes are 18.4 with a 20" max rim width.
13. Stock sheet metal and hoods. Stock wheel base.
14. **Div. FC** tractors can pull in up to 2 weight classes as they choose. (One hook per class.)
15. All tractors must weigh in with signed up driver before each pull.
16. Full Cut Weight Classes are: 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000.

**ATTENTION: TRACTOR PULLERS: Use Spectator Entrance. Exit new road to Hwy 50. Look for signs.**  
**EXHIBITORS: Use Exhibitor Entrance one block east of Spectator Entrance.**  
**FLEA MARKET EXHIBITORS: Use Spectator Entrance.**
