



Creativity: the use of imagination or original ideas to create something; inventiveness.


Conveniently: fitting in well with a person's needs, activities, and plans. **Conceptualization:** the action or process of forming a concept or idea of something.


Captivation: capable of attracting and holding interest; charming.


Conviviality: the quality of being friendly and lively; friendliness.


Communication: the imparting or exchanging of information by speaking, writing, or using some other medium Project


Creation: the action or process of bringing something into existence.


Collaboration: produced by or involving two or more parties working together.


Caring: displaying kindness and concern for others.
