Cost for Workshops:

We have a <u>requested amount of at least \$10</u>, more is always appreciated, to be dropped in the can provided for each workshop. This money goes toward that teacher for her time to prepare for your workshop as well as her time that day and to help replenish any supplies, dyes, paints, or inks they may have shared with you, not included in a kit. This requested \$10 is above and beyond any kit/supply fees. There is also a can in the Guided Play areas for donation toward replenishing supplies for those stations. Please check out what the dyes, paints, and other items supplied to you cost. Leave enough money in the cans to help replenish the supplies for the amount you may have used. There is also a donation can for the use of the building and toward electricity, etc.

Kits or Supply Fees:

When a kit or supply fee is involved, there will still be a donation can for you to give the requested \$10 toward the teacher's time in addition to the cost of the kit. Some workshops have a supply fee or kits available for purchase. The teacher must be notified by May 8 so the right number of kits or supplies can be available.

<u>DEADLINE MAY 8:</u> Please sign up for workshops with the teacher as some have a size limit, kit/supply fee, or bring from their stash to share and need time to prepare. Contact info for each teacher is in each workshop description.

Drop Cords & multi plugins if using a sewing machine or other electrical appliance.

OPTIONAL: Any paints, dyes, etc. you may have purchased and don't have the space or courage to play with in your home.

Chair if you have one you prefer. A folding chair is provided.
