Did You Know:

- The club is discussing installing a bulletin board for information to be posted for all to see to anytime. This is an item that is being researched and voted on. Make sure to attend the meeting in person or via zoom to be a part of the decision.
- The clubs March 3, 2016 bylaws have been updated. Changes were accepted and approved in March's meeting.
- The club has an official Mission Statement and Purpose:
 - Mission Statement: To promote a fun activity for its members and the residents of CantaMia (CM). In addition, our activities will enhance social interaction and physical wellness.
 - Purpose: The purpose of the CantaMia Pickleball Club is to foster the opportunity, for as many CM residents as possible, to learn, enjoy and promote the game of pickleball.
- ◆ Starting April 11th, Member Greg Cunningham will be leading Drop In and Drill after open play. No sign-up needed, just show up.
- Visitors are required to sign-in at the village center front desk and pay the daily fee every time they play on CantaMia courts. Visitors under age 18 are not allowed on the courts. These are HOA rules, not club rules.
- During open play, court 6 is for novice players. If there are no novice players are on the court, anyone can play. If novice players arrive please allow them to play once the current game is finished.
- So far there has been more than 150 participants this season in the Skills Development classes!
- Random Pickleball Rule: Section 6 Line Call Rules: 6.B. Except the serve, any ball in play that lands in the court or touches any court line is in.
