Proposal to add Junior Z Clubs to Z & Golden Z Clubs: Article XII Committees, SECTION 12. Z Club and Golden Z Club Committee.

Proposal 3

Proposal to add Junior Z Clubs to Z & Golden Z Clubs:

Article XIV Clubs, SECTION 10. Z Club and Golden Z Club Committee.

Present Wording

(a) Z clubs and Golden Z clubs are service programs formed and sponsored by a Zonta club. Guidelines are in the Zonta International Z Club and Golden Z Club Manual. (b) The sponsoring Zonta club shall pay a charter fee and an annual renewal fee in US dollars. The renewal fee shall be used toward the administration of the Z Club program of Zonta International.

Proposed Wording

(a) Z clubs, Junior Z clubs, and Golden Z clubs are service programs formed and sponsored by a Zonta club. Guidelines are in the Zonta International Z Club, Junior Z clubs, and Golden Z Club Manual. (b) The sponsoring Zonta club shall pay a charter fee and an annual renewal fee in US dollars. The renewal fee shall be used toward the administration of the Z Club program of Zonta International. (c) Junior Z Club will operate under the auspices of the school where it is formed and functions. Privacy and Insurance Liability would be covered under the school policies and guidelines.
