





D9 and The Endowment Fund (TEF)

So far this biennium--June 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021:



- Clubs
 - 1 of 25 clubs (4%) have made a gift to TEF
 - D9 ranks 19th (of 31 districts) in size
 - D9 ranks 13th (of 31 districts) in number of clubs giving
- Members
 - 17 of 421 members (4%) have made an individual gift to TEF; about 1.5 on average per club
 - D9 ranks 3rd (of 31) in number of members giving
- Total contributions are \$14,040 (4th of 31)
- STILL WE CAN DO BETTER


D9 October-December 2021 Challenge Match for TEF




- Pledge of \$35,000 to match club and individual donations
- Goals
 - 5 clubs give \$500 between October 1 and December 15
 - 50 Zontians give \$300 or more between October 1 and December 15
- Matching Funds Challenge
 - 5 clubs x \$500 = \$2,500 plus \$5,000 from the pledge = \$7,500
 - 15 members x \$300 = \$4,500 plus \$9,000 from the pledge = \$13,500
 - 25 members x \$300 = \$7,500 plus \$15,000 from the pledge = \$22,500
 - 50 members x \$300 = \$15,000 plus \$30,000 from the pledge = \$45,000
 - Total = \$17,500 from D9 clubs and members plus \$35,000 from the pledge = a TOTAL of \$52,500



Paid Members as of May 31, 2020 = 28,091

August 31, 2021 = 24,732

15 month Loss of 3,359 members or 11.95%




