There was a discussion of speeding on Hudson Bend Rd. Sandy has been to the Sherriff's dept. and also contacted Travis County Transportation and Natural Resources. Brian Burk with the county is coming out to evaluate the possibility of additional speed limit signs. He also provided info on radar signs, which he said our neighborhood would have to pay for. They are way too expensive. The county will put up a temporary radar sign but for only 5-7 days.
