Founding member of the Rhode Island Rhythm & Blues Preservation Society, performer and now author, Eddie "Prof" Coates just released his new book **SPOOKS The Journey of Rhythm & Blues from Africa to Rhode Island**. Praised for the Book include support from RIRBPS President, Cleveland Kurtz who stated "for those, who like me, love to read the history of black music and the role it played in our society; this book is a great read".

As a reviewer I provided editorial review and found the material in this book to be outstanding for its' breadth and depth. Reading it provided insights that I would have never imagined ... as I was both educated and entertained. The inclusion of historical data on the pioneers of "Black" music was timely. The Book chronicles the evolution of R&B in Rhode Island compiled from the author's personal experiences, oral histories and printed sources. Eddie "Prof" Coates relied on much of the archive information compiled by the Rhode Island Rhythm & Blues Preservation Society including videos, written archives, oral testimonies and photos housed at the Rhode Island Historical Society and the RIRBPS. He acknowledged that "much of the information and images presented in the production of this material was compiled from data found in and credited to the collection of the RI Rhythm & Blues Preservation Society..."
