



TOPIC: BIND THEM IN BUNDLES TO BE BURNED

Scriptures:

Isaiah 66 v5: "Hear ye the word of the Lord, ye that tremble at his word; your brethren that hated

you, that cast you out for my name sake said, let the Lord be glorified: but he shall

appear to your joy and they shall be ashamed."

Proverbs 6 v16-19: (v16) "These six things doth the Lord hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him."

(v17) "A proud look, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood,

(v18) "An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,"

(v19) "A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brothren"

The time has come to burn the tares. This action will not be done by man, but by God's angels (Matt 13 v30). This action will be completed by a special brand of eagle angels called reapers (Matt 24 v28). The Prophet Webb informed HOZ that these brands of angels have had the spirit of mercy removed from their being by God. They cannot hear pleas for mercy from any victim. They will seek and destroy until the Lord says stop or the reason for slaughtering is gone (Ezekiel 9 v4-11 and 2 Samuels 24 V15-16).

Let us examine the following words with definition from Webster:

• Divination: An attempt to tell the unknown by occult means

• Sorcery: The supposed use of an evil supernatural power over people and their affairs; to bewitch,

to hold spellbound.

Now please examine with us the Prophet Ezekiel as he warns us against the foolish lies of men claiming to be prophets speaking lies and false visions from their own imaginations in Ezekiel 13 v1-10 and verses 22 and 23. Upon reading we notice here that the Prophet Ezekiel tells us exactly what to look for and how to recognize these prophets of darkness. The Prophet Jeremiah also gave warning concerning these false and evil servants of the dragon in Jeremiah 14 v14-15.

The Tabernacle of David has been attacked with this same spirit force of evil, which has elevated her tares to unquestionable status as they attack the doctrine with ungodliness. Already we have written much concerning these evil tares that head the leadership of the church. [Please see our letter on our www.godssaints.org website's "Heralding News Letters (HNL)" section entitled, These people – and all those who are permanently bound to them by doctrine – have but one destiny: that is death by the hands of the eagle angels of God (Ezekiel 9th chapter; noting verse 6 quoting, "Slay utterly old and young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not near any man upon whom is the mark; and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which were before the house.")
