## CHAPTER XVIII

## WOE! WOE! WOE! TO THE EARTH

Before we deal with the three "Woe" trumpets, let us notice the two prophets standing before him (the Lord) in the earth. As the plagues of the wrath of God are poured upon it, to prophesy the coming of these plagues against the world, they (the two prophets) will pinpoint the *time*, *place* and *nature* of the plagues under each blast of the trumpets (*Revelation* 11:3-13 [see appendix]). But the wicked will blame the plagues on the two prophets, and they will become tormentors to them; and God shall arm them with great power (note closely verse 5 and 6 of this chapter). We shall again notice the two prophets as we progress with the "woes", but for now we go back to Revelation 8:13, and it reads: "AND I BEHELD, AND HEARD AN ANGEL FLYING THROUGH THE MIDST OF HEAVEN, SAYING WITH A LOUD VOICE, WOE, WOE, WOE, TO THE INHABITERS OF THE EARTH BY REASON OF THE OTHER VOICES OF THE TRUMPET OF THE THREE ANGELS, WHICH ARE YET TO SOUND!"
